Program Information

All Classes are held at St. Patrick's School

Class times:

First day of class:

Tuesday classes begin on September 12, 2017
at St. Patrick's School

Sunday classes begin on September 10, 2017
at St. Patrick's School

Drop off before class:

- Tuesday afternoon: Students are NOT to be dropped off before 3:30. Each week students are to gather in the gym where the teachers will meet them at 3:45.
- Tuesday Evening: Students are to report directly to the classroom but they are not to enter the classroom if their teacher or aide are not present.
- Sunday classes: Students are to report directly to the classroom but they are not to enter the classroom if their teacher or aide are not present

Dismissal:

- **Tuesday afternoon dismissal for Grades 1-4:**
Children will be dismissed from their classrooms where they must be signed out by a parent/guardian.
- **Tuesday evening dismissal for Grades 5-8:**
Children are dismissed from their classroom and are to be picked up in front of the school building by 8:30.
- **Sunday dismissal for Grades 1-5:**
Children will be dismissed from their classrooms where they must be signed out by a parent/guardian.
- **Sunday dismissal for Grades 6-8:**
Children are dismissed from their classrooms.

Community Service Requirements:

Students in all grades and their families are encouraged to perform service in the community. In preparation for Confirmation the older students have the following requirements:

7 th grade students:	8 hours
8 th grade students:	15 hours

Mass attendance:

The success of our program depends upon the strength of the commitment that each family makes to support our efforts in the classroom as we teach our faith to your children. Weekly Mass Attendance is required.

Behavior in class:

We expect each student to show respect for the catechist and aide and come with a true willingness to grow in our faith. If this respect is not evident in the classroom, a meeting will then be held with the director, catechist, parent and child to resolve the problem.

Early dismissal:

Students are expected to attend the entire class period. Leaving early from class will be considered an absence.
