Meeting for Liturgical Ministers

The Worship Committee and I are announcing a meeting for all Readers (Lectors) and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. This meeting will be held on Saturday, February 4, 2017 from 10:00am until 11:30am.

The purpose of this meeting is to update all of our Liturgical Ministers on the latest guidelines concerning these ministries coming from Rome, the USCCB in Washington D.C., and from the Archdiocese of New York.

The first part will center on the Theology of these two ministries and the second part will focus on our local adaptation and praxis. Because of the importance of these two presentations we are scheduling a repeat of this meeting on the following Saturday, February 11, 2017, also from 10:00am to 11:30am.

For anyone interested in becoming a Reader or Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion either of these meetings could serve as your introduction and then you would be invited to a further meeting centering in on one of these ministries. The usual rules apply: anyone interested in serving in the Sanctuary must be Fully Initiated into the Roman Catholic Church by receiving the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Communion. To be a EMHC you must be 18 years of age or older. If you are married your marriage must be recognized by the Catholic Church. In recognizing that no person is sinless we ask you to refrain from serving in these ministries if doing so would cause a public scandal. In particular, you must accept the Church's teaching concerning the sanctity of all human life, born and unborn.

For all those who have been serving may the Lord bless you for your generosity and I pray that we will grow in our love for God and His Church.


