

Mother's Day

This year we are doing things a little differently in our celebration of Mother's Day. There are Mother's Day cards available at the entrances to the Church. No intentions have been taken for any of the Masses on Sunday, May 13th. Every Mass will be offered for our living or deceased Mothers whose name's will be placed on the Altar. The Mass of Anticipation, Saturday evening at 5:30pm will be offered for the living and deceased members of the Parish that must be offered every weekend

The cards have two envelopes, one for the card itself and the larger one to be filled out with the mother's name and checking off if she is alive or deceased, and then handed in before the actual date. A "free will offering" will be appreciated but is not mandatory. There will be some larger envelopes, without cards, available for those for whom no card is necessary. For example, those whose grandmothers, mothers, or Godmothers are all deceased.

The Crowning of a statue of Our Blessed Mother will also take place at the end of each Mass. We ask that one boy and one girl who have received First Holy Communion this year could volunteer to take part in the Crowning wearing their Communion outfits. More on this next week.
